RULES AND REGULATIONS
CLUBHOUSE COMPLEX
POOL AND HOT TUB (SPA)

The pool is open for residents and their guests from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm.

Residents are responsible for the behavior of their guests and must remain with them.

NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY.

A first aid kit is in the Main Clubhouse, located adjacent to ladies' bathroom door.

An emergency phone is in the Main Clubhouse located on the kitchen counter in addition to a phone outside, located to the left of the basement steps for the small clubhouse.

Take a shower before entering the pool or hot tub. Soap is not permitted in the shower.

Do not wear jewelry in the pool or hot tub as the chemicals can react to some metals.

The maximum number of swimmers allowed in the pool at any one time is 15 (fifteen).

Children aged 16 (sixteen) and under may use the pool only under adult supervision from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm, and from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm **MONDAY THRU FRIDAY**.

There are no age restrictions on **SATURDAY AND SUNDAY**.

People wearing diapers and/or waterproof pants are not permitted in the pool. Watertight swim diapers are permitted.

Children under 12 (twelve) are not allowed in the hot tub at any time. This is for the health and safety of the child.

All people using the pool do so at their own risk. Residents and/or the RHOA are not responsible for any accident, injury, loss or liability in the pool or hot tub.

Running, boisterous or rough play, ball playing, Frisbees, diving, or jumping into the pool are prohibited.

No toys, floating objects, snorkels, fins or floating mattresses are permitted.

Swim aids that are designed to aid in swimming or water safety and water weights used for water aerobics are permitted.

Adults should not swim alone.

Individual usage of radios, tape and CD players is not permitted except when used with earphones.

Smoking in the pool, hot tub, and patio is prohibited.

No glassware or glass bottles are allowed in the pool area.

Residents and guests must clean up after themselves. All trash must be taken home for disposal. Trash bags are located in the kitchen area of the Main Clubhouse.

No person under the influence of drugs or alcohol may use the pool or hot tub.

Pets are prohibited in the pool, hot tub and adjacent area.

No one with skin, eye, ear, nasal infection, communicable disease, or illness may use the pool or hot tub.

Restroom access is restricted to the single door of the Main Clubhouse adjacent to the pool and restrooms, not the Main Clubhouse front door. The volunteer tasked with opening the pool in the morning will unlock the door; the volunteer tasked with closing the pool will lock the door in the evening.

In the event of lightning, thunder, or rain everyone **MUST EXIT** the pool and hot tub immediately.

Everyone must exit the pool and/or hot tub when maintenance is needed.

The RHOA reserves the right to deny use of the pool, hot tub and adjacent area to anyone at any time, and to close the pool and/or hot tub without notice.
